



HESSER COLLEGE ESSENTIAL RESIDENTIAL LIFE INFORMATION

Meal Plan

A meal plan allows you to put a specific amount of money on your ID card that can be used at the Café, located on the first floor of the residence hall or the Bistro on the second floor of the residence hall. Meal plans are required for all residents and offered to commuting students as well.

Telephone Service

Each room has an installed and active phone line for local calls. Please bring your own phone (an answering service is provided with the telephone service) and plug it into the phone jack in your room. College staff will call you on your local phone line, not your cell phone. There are no additional charges for local calls and long distance calls can be placed using your cell phone or any toll free calling card. All students will receive the phone number for their room upon checking in to the residence halls. NOTE to Parents & Families: For security purposes Residence Life can not give out any personal student information including room number and phone number. Please be sure to get this information from your student before leaving.

Internet

You and your roommate each have a computer port for access to the College's high speed Internet. Internet access is free through Hesser College. In order to qualify for this service, you must be an on-campus student with your own computer. Your computer must meet the following minimal requirements.

- Intel-based PC: Intel or AMD Processor, Windows XP, 2000 64 MB RAM, Twisted pair Ethernet network adapter and Cat5 cable.
- Macintosh Computer: 64000 or PowerPC processor, System 7.5 or higher, 64 MB RAM, Open Transport 1.1.2 (or higher), Twisted pair Ethernet network adapter (Apple or Asante)
- Your computer will need to be equipped with a 10/100 Base-T Ethernet card adapter and you will need a CAT5e network cable.

Cable Television

Comcast offers cable television in your rooms (for a fee). There is cable television available in all 3 student lounges.

Laundry Services

Each floor has its own laundry facility. You will use a LECO Laundry Card to pay for the laundry machines (\$5 dollar increments). You can insert money onto your Laundry Card via the Laundry Card machine located outside the campus bookstore on the first floor of the residence hall. Wash is \$1.25, dry is \$1.25. Don't forget to bring laundry detergent!

Renters Insurance

Although precaution is taken to maintain adequate security, the College cannot assume the responsibility for the loss of or damage to student possessions. We encourage you to consult an insurance agent to purchase renter's insurance to cover your items while residing at Hesser College.
